Refuge in Sanibel. Phil Nye, one of our board members and an avid bird watcher was our guide. He gave us a wealth of information regarding many of the birds that migrate to our area in the winter. The weather was very sunny and a little warm, but near the water it was delightful. We saw white pelicans, that have a beautiful pink belly and when in flight; they were magnificent. We also saw brown pelicans, snowy egret, egret, and many others. We then went to the Mucky Duck for lunch. All had a great time. Join us on our other field trips.
