




District 4 Sea Turtle Nesting Success

**Delnor Wiggins:** 

Delnor Wiggins Pass had 30 loggerhead nests this season, with 1655 successful hatchlings. This equates to 690 hatchlings per kilometer (1103 per mile). Fire ants predated heavily here, negatively affecting seven nests. Andro was applied, but nests were still found full of ants. The high

abundance of ants could be due to the close proximity of parking areas to beach dune communities. Four nests were predated by raccoons, and one nest was affected by ghost crabs and laughing gulls. One nest was also impacted by a human visitor, with the sign and cage pulled off and left lying next to the nest on the beach. Considering how small Delnor is, and how high the visitor impact is here, the sea turtles still had extremely high nesting success. More attention to fire ant population control should help increase this success even more next season. Also, park staff should continue to trap nuisance raccoons. This nesting season, 20 raccoons were successfully removed, ultimately keeping hatchling success high for this park.
